The All India Industrial Exhibition, which has its origins in 1938 as "Numaish-Masunaat-e-Mulki", is an annual event eagerly awaited by traders from all over India and residents of Telangana. The 46-day event, also called 'The Numaish' is held every year from 1st January to 15th February, at the sprawling Exhibition Grounds. Being centrally located the Exhibition is accessible from all corners of the twin cities by road. It is surrounded by hotels, banks, GPO and other amenities.

This 46-day annual gala is considered one of the biggest trade events in South Asia. On an average about 25 Lakh people visit this exhibition every year. A notable feature of the exhibition is that vendors ranging from small to medium and large scale enterprises participate and attract visitors from all over.

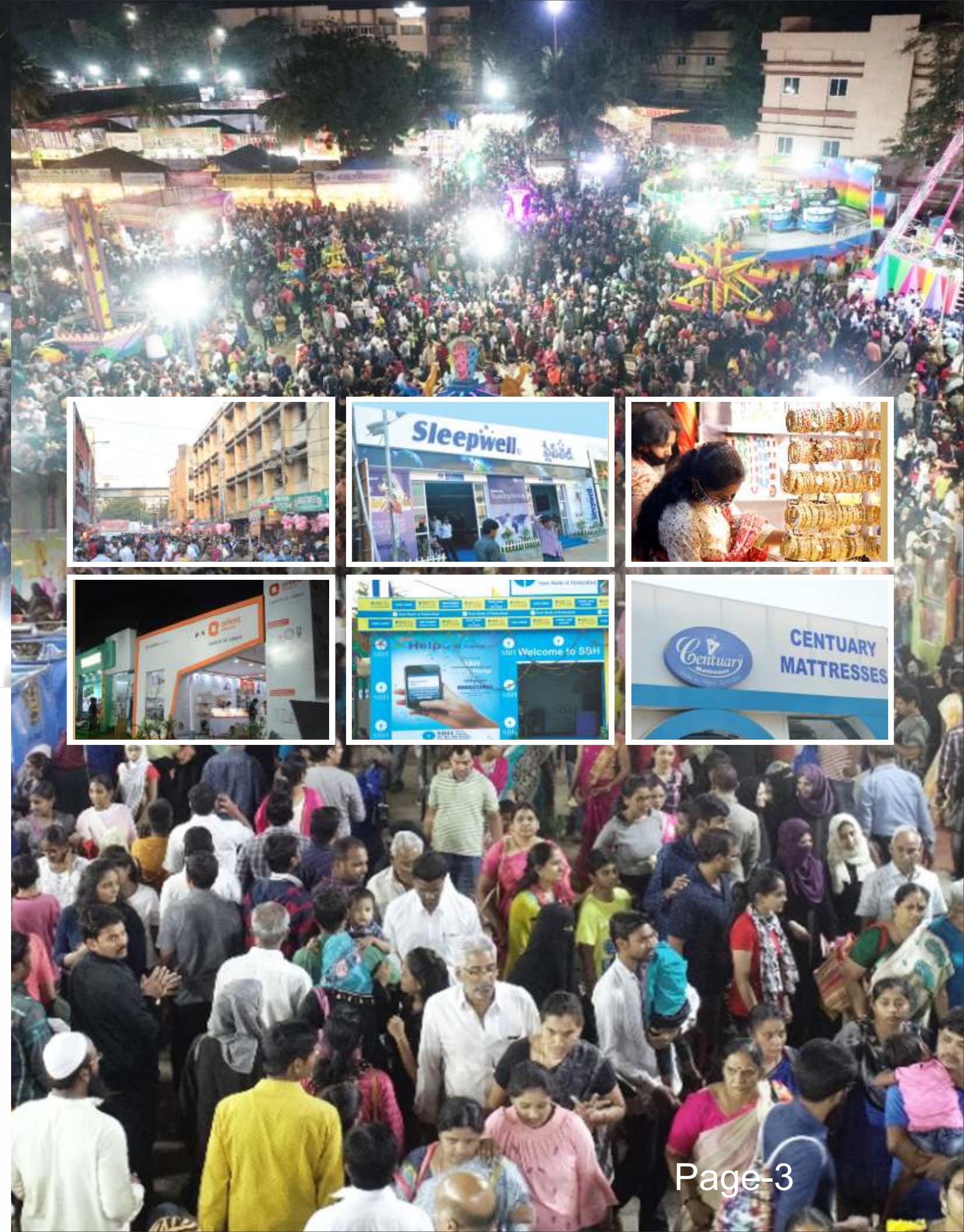
